[FOR THE ATTENTION OF RESIDENTS OF LEISURE PARK]

01ST FEBRUARY, 2024

To consider the issues raised by the Residents of Leisure Park particularly following the recent incident when a Resident was manhandled by security staff.

The Receiver and the Committee had a meeting today.

Various points have been raised by many residents before the Receiver through several messages for consideration.

The Receiver and the Committee appeal to all the residents to maintain peace and solidarity at any cost. Without going into allegations and counter allegations the Committee condemns such incidents. It is the common responsibility of all Residents and more importantly the Committee of management, ad hoc or otherwise, to ensure that peace is maintained and all staff behave properly with civility and due respect to all Residents.

Since the status of present ad hoc committee is under debate, it is important that on or before 28/02/2024, a fresh ad hoc committee is elected, before election for a permanent Association is conducted. But this is not any adverse comment on any one. It is important that no one devalues the office of the Receiver. The Committee appeals to all to extend cooperation.

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that no unapproved commercial activities be done in the project.

Receiver and the Committee decided to receive further representations from any of the residents of Leisure Park in order that every resident feels assured that their issues are being addressed.

Mr. D.K. Mishra, one of the Committee Member has been authorized to receive such representation on 03.02.2024 between 3.00 and 5.00 PM. It is advisable to maintain limited number of representatives which would be conducive.

The current ad hoc committee will abide this instruction and will continue to co-operate with the Committee and its advices. Any matter relating to NBCC also will be resolved as maybe required.
